2 Conditions

Registration

1. Skip bin companies must be registered with Council to operate within the Blacktown local government area.
2. We reserve the right to rescind any approval of registration. Notice of any rescission will be provided in writing.
3. Registered companies are not required to submit application for road occupancy for bin placement on roads.
4. Companies that are not registered are required to obtain a Road Occupancy Licence (ROL) before placing skip bins on any road.
5. Companies that are not registered and supply/place skip bins on roads in Blacktown without Council consent may attract infringement notices.

Appearance and safety

6. Each skip bin must bear the name and telephone number of the supplier.
7. Bins must be in good condition and adequately cleaned prior to delivery.
8. Bins are to be painted a light bright colour such as white, yellow or orange so that

they are easily visible especially during night or limited visibility times. Dark colours such as black, blue and dark green are not allowed.

9. Bins are to be visible to all oncoming traffic by having reflectors or retro reflective on the outside walls and be mounted with flashing yellow lights when in badly lit areas or as requested by Council. Badly lit areas are locations where there is no street lighting or if the bins are placed under large trees.

10. Registered companies are permitted to place skip bins on Council controlled roads.

11. Skip bins are not permitted:

- a. on roads where signs indicate kerbside parking restrictions apply. This includes, but is not limited to: No Stopping, Clearway, No Standing, No Parking, Construction Zones, Loading Zones, period parking, resident parking.
- b. on roads where parking is prohibited under various acts of law, including but not limited to:
 - at an intersection or within 10 metres of the intersecting street kerb alignment without traffic lights and 20 metres at the intersection with traffic lights
 - within 20 metres of the approach side and 10 metres on the departure side of a pedestrian crossing
 - within 20 metres of the approach side and 10 metres on the departure side of a children's crossing
 - within 20 metres of the approach side and 10 metres on the departure side of a bus stop
 - within 20 metres of the approach side and 20 metres on the departure side of a railway level crossing
 - on a hill or curve where the view is not clear for at least 50 metres
 - within 3 metres from any separation lines
 - on a median strip or traffic island.
- c. on vehicular crossings in areas that obstruct vehicular traffic entering or leaving premises
- d. in locations which obstruct pedestrian traffic entering or leaving premises
- e. in locations which obstruct access to utility service manholes or devices which require servicing (e.g. traffic signal boxes, Telstra pillars)
- f. at an intersection or within 6 metres of the property line at the intersection (whether controlled by traffic signals or not)
- g. at locations which interfere with the sight lines of drivers entering or leaving premises
- h. in locations directly above underground services, unless special arrangements are made to protect these services from potential damage
- i. at any other location considered inappropriate by Council's Officer.

12. Council's advice should be sought if the placement of a skip bin is proposed:

- a. in a narrow street where it may restrict normal traffic locations
- b. at a location that will interfere or block the operations of driveways other than the hirer's driveway
- c. at a location that will interfere or block the movement of vehicles in travelling lanes
- d. at a location which interfere with the sight lines of drivers entering or leaving premises
- e. at a location that will interfere with or block the movement of pedestrians.

Breaches

13. In the event of a breach of these conditions, a Council officer will notify the registered provider to comply within a fixed time period. Non-compliance may result in our issuing an infringement notice or cancellation of approval to place skip

bins within Blacktown City.

- Prohibited waste**
- 14. Industrial or hazardous wastes must not be placed in any skip bin on a public road.
 - 15. Asbestos material is to be disposed of in line with SafeWork NSW requirements.
- Transportation**
- 16. All skip bins are to be covered during transit. The skip bin company will ensure compliance with relevant Australian Standards and rules.
 - 17. The skip bin supplier shall be responsible for removal of any waste material spilled over from the bin.

3 Fees and payment
