Policy

- 1. Roadside memorials are not encouraged by Council. However, Council will not object to their placement unless a complaint is received.**
- 2. Memorials that are the subject of complaints are to be inspected and if possible the person who placed the memorial contacted.**
- 3. Alternative arrangements may be made for the repair, removal or relocation of the memorial, or a suitable remembrance tree planted if Council is requested to do so.**

Procedure

- When a roadside memorial is reported to Council:
- the MES will investigate the matter and determine if the memorial is unsightly or a distraction or danger to motorists and pedestrians.
 - If the memorial needs to be removed, repaired or relocated then Council will try and contact the person who placed the memorial.
 - If asked, Council may plant a remembrance tree.
 - If the person cannot be reached, then Council may remove the memorial.
